**Baptism – Infant:** Baptisms are only scheduled on specific weekends throughout the year at liturgies. Please check inside this bulletin for upcoming Baptism dates. A required initial parent preparation session occurs several weeks before the Baptism. To register for the next parent session and schedule your child's Baptism, please call the Parish Office. An additional required session is also held just prior to the Baptism.

**Marriage:** Please call the Parish Office. Minimum of six months preparation time.

**Anointing/Hospital Visit:** If you or someone you know is being admitted to Chesapeake General Hospital, please call the office so we may share Eucharist with them and/or celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick.

**Confirmation (Youth)** may celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation when they are in the tenth grade and are at least 15 years of age. In addition to the Confirmation program, each confirmandi must also be enrolled in a religious education program. Confirmation is normally celebrated during the Easter Season. Contact Sister Dolores at the Parish Office for additional information.

**Confirmation (Adult):** Baptized Adults who have received their first Eucharist and wish to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation participate in an eight-week process usually beginning in Lent. Contact Sister Dolores at the Parish Office for information.

**Adults for Baptism or Reception into the Catholic Church:** Adults who have not been baptized or wish to be received into the Catholic Church participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). **Children:** The process is adapted for children 7 years of age or older. Contact Sister Dolores at the Parish Office for information.

**Holy Orders, Religious Life and Lay Ministry:** Men and women who are considering Holy Orders, Religious Life, or Lay Ministry are encouraged to call Fr. Jazmin at the Parish Office for information.

*Take a little time to ponder. This moment can be a source of discussion in your family, your Bible Study group, or Religious Education class*

#### TAKE A VACATION...IT'S BIBLICAL

Ponder this...especially during the summer months, many people go on vacation. With the kids out of school and the rush of warmer weather (at least for half of the planet) upon us, many head to the sandy beaches and to other vacation destinations. Have you ever considered what the Lord has to say about our periods of rest and relaxation? Could our vacationing have foundations in the Bible?

The good news is that the Lord actually "vacationed." God, himself, rested on the seventh day and created Sundays as our weekly day of rest and relaxation. God knew that we, too, need a time to "recharge our batteries" after six days of work.

Sacred Scripture also tells us that Jesus went away from time to time to rest and get away from the day-to-day routine. He spent time away from the crowds and retreated to places of quiet solitude to pray.

**We are Catholic.** Jesus sets the example for us to follow, to take breaks that will renew our spirit. He wants us to rest from our normal schedules and take time for relaxation to explore the world around us. He wants us to enjoy all that God has created and reunite with Him during these times of renewal. It is actually biblical that we take a vacation to reunite with others and with God.

The Great Exchange works on a point system. One piece of clothing donated is equal to one piece of clothing being able to be pulled. For each piece donated by our parishioners under the Prince of Peace account, one point will be added to our account. Two-piece outfits are worth two points.

**You may bring up to 25 pieces of clothing per visit to donate.** During special times of the year, they offer unlimited intake on items. **Fall/winter clothing is generally accepted October-March. Spring/summer clothing is generally accepted April-September.**

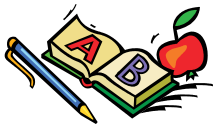
