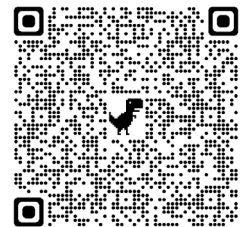
THANKSGIVING DINNER FOR MEALS ON WHEELS CLIENTS:

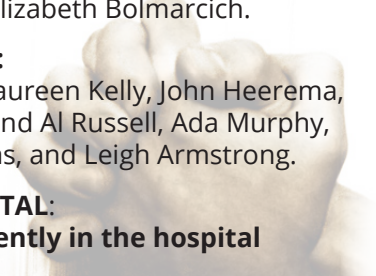

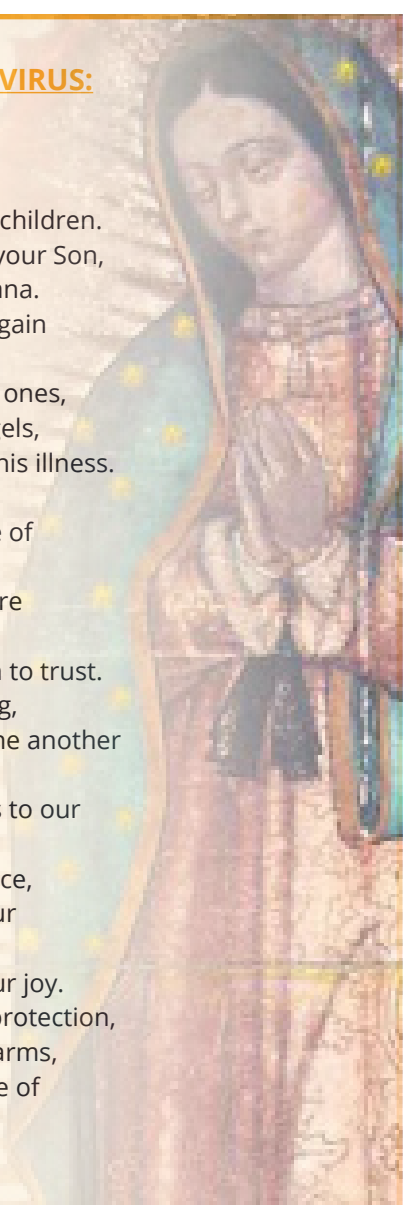

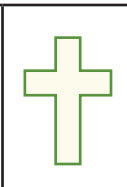
