THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Monday, August 15, 2022 is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Because it falls on a Monday this year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. A Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 a.m. at Prince of Peace on Monday, August 15, 2022. It will not be livestreamed.

SACRAMENTS



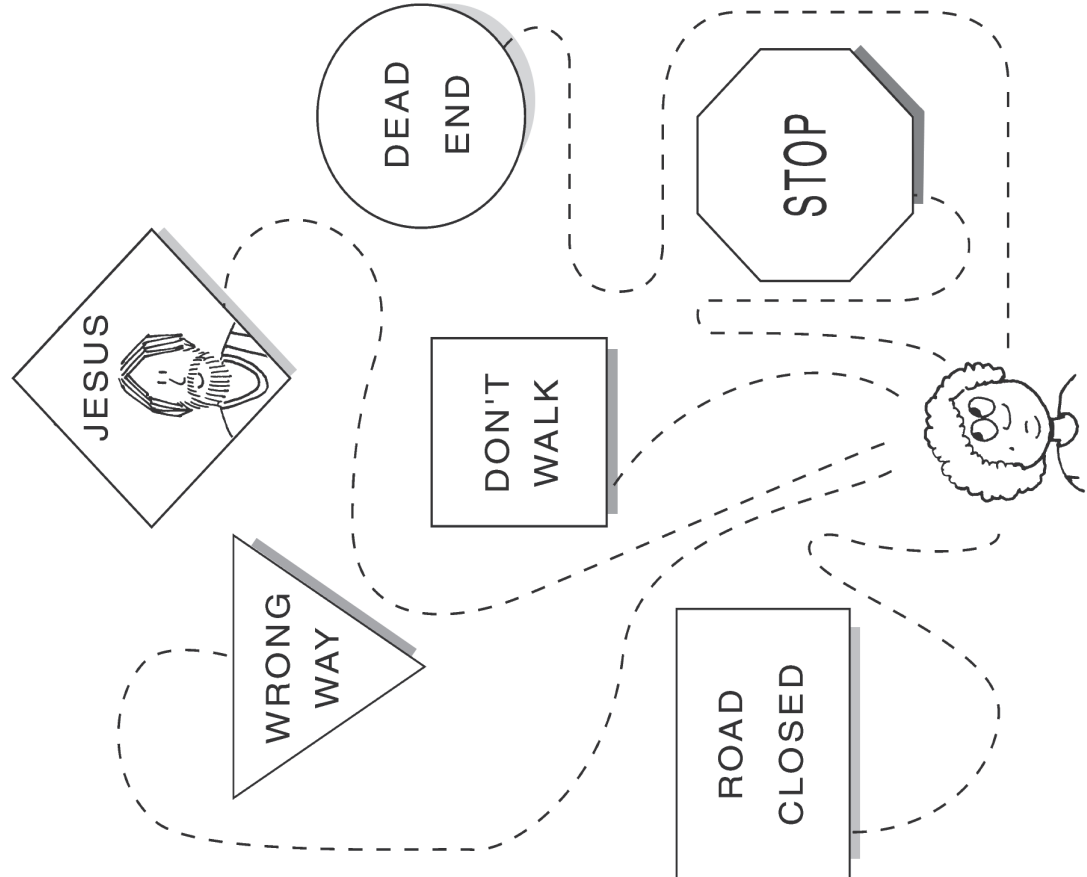

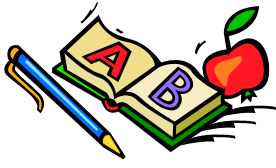
