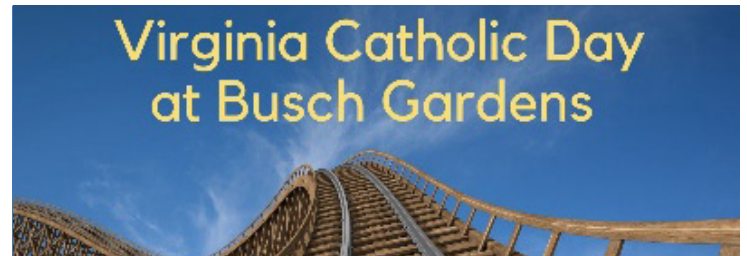

Classes begin the week of October 2 and **all volunteers are needed** to help make this year successful.

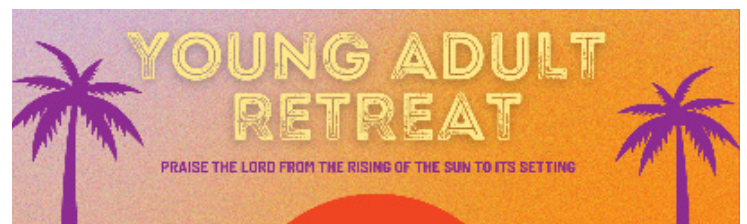
