After breakfast we visit Jordan River where Jesus was baptized and will continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes. Here Jesus proclaimed his Sermon on the Mount. Drive to Capernaum, the town of Jesus which is the center of his ministry where he performed many miracles. Visit the House of St. Peter and the ruins of the ancient Synagogue where Jesus preached. Stop at Tabgha, the Primacy of St. Peter and visit The Church of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes; the site of the multiplication miracle. Followed by a boat ride on the Lake of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Nazareth

Day 8 March 20, Monday, Galilee, Jerusalem, Bethlehem

After breakfast continue to Bethlehem and visit Church of Nativity in Bethlehem where Jesus was born. Celebrate Mass here. Visit Milk Grotto and the Shepherd's Field. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9, March 21, Tuesday, Jerusalem






