

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT MARCH 5, 2023

#### **2023 ANNUAL APPEAL:**

Once again this year, Prince of Peace is participating in the Annual Diocesan Appeal. The Appeal is a yearly opportunity to support the next generation, provide for those in need and build up our Catholic communities. Each gift that is contributed to the Appeal makes a real difference because the gifts enable our Diocese to deliver needed ministries and services such as health insurance and long-term care for our retired priests, tuition for our future priests to attend the seminary and heating and grocery assistance to families through the Fuel and Hunger Fund, from which we again this year received a grant to assist our local community. In addition, all parishes receive back a portion of their funds to be used for local priorities.

In a profound moment, Jesus offered a taste of His divinity to Peter, James, and John in the Gospel today. Jesus made known the glory He had with the Father before the world began. These three disciples were privileged to witness the manifestation of the Transfiguration.

As powerful as the Transfiguration must have been (Peter was so awed, he didn't even know what He said), that encounter can't equal receiving the Eucharist! Receiving an image of God through one's eyes can't rival the privilege of taking God Himself into one's body through the Eucharist.

Our community needs to know about this. When you support the Annual Diocesan Appeal, you help our parish to get the word out: God is here! He lives in our little tabernacle! It's a secret that shouldn't be kept. God doesn't want to overpower us with His transfigured divinity every day. God's care is manifest in the Eucharist: its humble appearance enables the fragile human heart to "fill that gap" with faith.

As Saint Thomas Aguinas says, where "our feeble senses fail," faith rises (the *Tantum Ergo*). Please help our parish facilitate these privileged encounters by supporting the Appeal. Through your generosity, you'll help us provide the Eucharist to all who seek it in the guiet, human way our Lord seems to prefer.

#### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Father John Bosco will lead the Stations of the Cross immediately following our 9:00 a.m. Daily Mass on Fridays during Lent. (Except First Friday). The Rosary will continue to be prayed after the 9:00 a.m. Daily Masses, Tuesdays-Thursdays.

#### REGULATIONS FOR FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Fasting is to be observed by all, 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. Abstinence is observed by all, 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Baptism or of Renewal of Baptism at Easter.




