### VIRTUS:

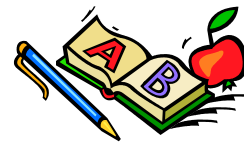

### TIGERS NEEDED!!!

On June 1st, 2025, Prince of Peace will celebrate its 50th Anniversary since the church's humble beginning in 1975. Father John has asked the Pastoral Council to take the lead in planning the celebration activities and, also, in getting the church's key worship

spaces, entrance, Commons area, and social hall "refreshed" for this important milestone. Current plans for the Refresh include using both outside contractors and Parishioners to form "Tiger Teams" needed to assist the church's Facility Manager in performing necessary repairs, cleaning, and painting of these highly visible areas.

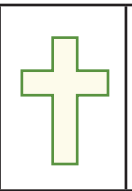
