WHERE DO OUR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT DONATIONS GO?

With the closing of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, we are providing an update on a couple of our major projects in the parish.

ADA 2021 – The AV Ministry project was closed out with the upgrading of the sound system in the church. This upgrade included the new speakers, mics and hearing aid devices. This project was paid for by the funds from the Annual Diocesan Appeal of FY 2021. The cost of the upgrade exceeded the funds collected by \$2,235.79.

ADA 2023 – Additionally, we closed the books on the Rectory Renovation. This brought the rectory up to date and provided some long overdue repairs. This project was paid for by the funds from the Annual Diocesan Appeal of FY 2023. The cost of the repairs and upgrades exceeded the funds collected by \$15,431.72. The excess funds needed for these important initiatives were provided by your ongoing contributions to our capital improvement fund. These important funds help with projects but also the ongoing maintenance of our building.

Celebrate Mass at the site where St Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631, directing him to the Grotto and to a well of miraculous curative waters. Visit the Grotto and healing waters. We will travel to the Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan to see the image of Our Lady burnt into a tree trunk after she appeared to Juan Diego Bernardino in 1541. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

DAY 4, March 17, 2025, Monday, Pyramids-Shrine of Our Lady-Mexico City

After breakfast, we will drive to Teotihuacan to see the Pyramid of the Sun and the Pyramid of the Moon and ancient structures. Our next visit is to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patroness of the Americas. Celebrate Mass in the brilliantly colored, modern Basilica dedicated in 1976. Join your prayers with those of other pilgrims as you kneel before the altar displaying the astounding Tilma, the sackcloth bearing the image of the Holy Virgin. Dinner and Overnight in Mexico City.

DAY 5, March 19, 2025, Tuesday- Zocola- Xochimilco-Coyoacan

Drive through the Zocalo, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and the National Palace and the Santo Domingo Church. We travel by way of the Plaza of the Three Cultures (Tlatelolco) to visit the baptismal place of Juan Diego. Then we will drive to Xochimilco to have a boat ride. End of the boat ride, we will drive to Covoacan to visit the church of St. John of the

Baptist, enjoy the traditional Mexican coffee "Café El Jarocho" and varieties flavors of churros. Then, visit the Church of San Jose del Altillo to see the crypt where Blessed Conchita Cabrera is buried. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.






