





#### WHO IS IT?

CAST is a Chesapeake organization led by Sam Howard of Great Bridge Presbyterian Church and is supported by Chesapeake area churches.

#### WHAT IS IT?

A confederation of area churches, synagogues, and other organizations that provide food, shelter and safety for the homeless in Chesapeake every winter.

#### WHERE IS IT?

CAST embraces the needs of the homeless in Chesapeake where there exists a significant homeless population. CAST supports one sponsor site each week starting with dinner on every Wednesday (late December through mid-April) and concluding after breakfast the following Wednesday. In the past, each church hosting the homeless did so in their own facilities. 


