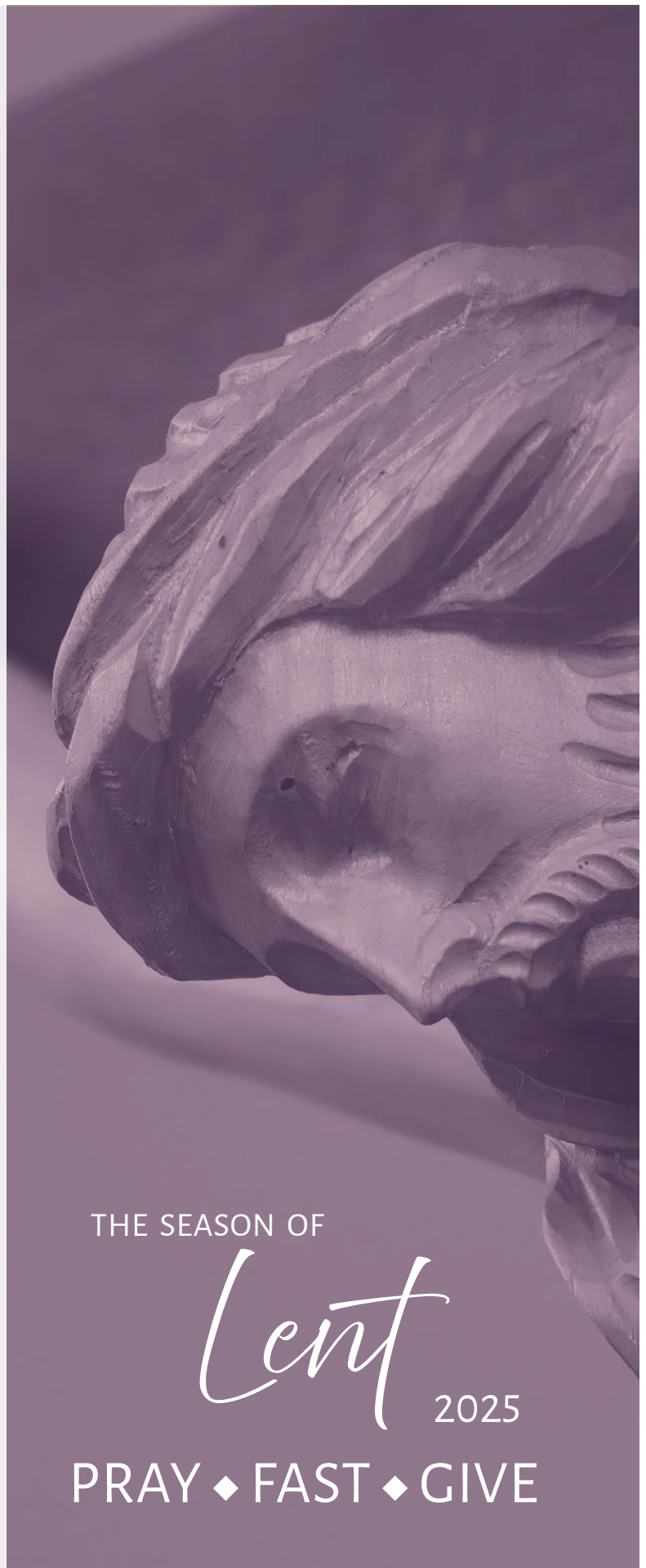

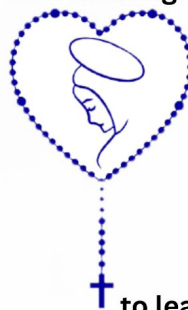
## IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution

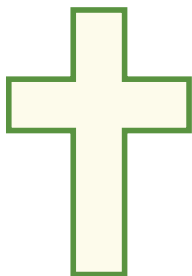
